Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics with Supervised Experiential Learning (Distance Education Program)





Program Description

The Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics with Supervised Experiential Learning (MSND-SEL) is a combined program that online-onsite practice integrates a Master of Science degree along with the 1,000 hours of alternate and supervised experiential learning required to become eligible to take the CDR credentialing exam for dietitian (RDN) nutritionists and meet state licensure eligibility requirements of Puerto Rico. The Program follows a Competency Based Education that integrates didactic education with supervised experiential learning (SEL).

The program offer more than 50% of the curriculum (didactic courses) in an online modality. The SEL hours consist of 280 hours of alternate experiential learning embedded in required courses and 720 hours, equivalent to 8 credits, to be completed in presential practice sites.
